PROGRAMS

Rescue Food Ministry: At each race venue, leftover untouched foods are collected from at-track hospitality units to donate to local community shelters and missions. At the end of the 2010 season, over \$1.3 million dollars in food value had been collected from the Team and IndyCar hospitality units and given to the poor. Thousands of pounds of soap and shampoo products were also collected and donated to the needy.
