


## **Business/status**

- A Myriad Yoga/opening in July
  Moving from Ninth Street and Capitol
  Avenue. In addition to yoga on the
  east side of the Stutz, Myriad will
  offer crossfit, bootcamp and
  weightlifting in the northwest corner.
- B Artist I, II and III/opening in August A committee will choose from applicants specializing in fields such as fine art, fashion design and music to use spaces whose residencies run mid-August to mid-May.
- Photo studio/opening in July
  Rental space for photo sessions of
  90 minutes and longer.
- D St'Artup 317/opening in July
  A local lifestyle brand is expected to
  be the first occupant of this business
  incubator. A second St'Artup 317 spot
  will open this fall on the west side of
  the complex.
- E Pattern/opening in July
  The not-for-profit creative agency
  and print magazine that launched in
  2010 serves as public art director at
  the Stutz.
- Grounded Plant & Floral Co./
  opened in May
  Purdue University alum Amanda
  Griffith opened the original Grounded
  Plant & Floral Co. in 2017.
- G Sculpture/to be installed next year An outdoor 3D art installation commissioned in conjunction with the city's Public Art for Neighborhoods Program. Artists submitted proposals earlier this year.



- Industrious/opened in January
  New York-based coworking company
  with room for 350 members in private
  offices, shared workspaces and
  conference rooms. Also has Mass Ave
  and Carmel locations.
- Amelia's Bread/opened May 31 Third location of Amelia's Bread. Fletcher Place bakery opened in 2012; Windsor Park shop opened in 2021.
- Barista Parlor/opening in July Coffee shop has eight locations in Nashville and one in Louisville. Stutz edition will feature a glossy white bar that replicates the oval of the Indianapolis Motor Speedway.
- Stutz Car Museum/opened in January

Museum showcases nine cars on loan from the collection of Turner Woodard, who sold a majority stake in the Stutz complex to real estate investment firm SomeraRoad Inc. in 2021.

- Turner's Bar/opening June 2 Named in tribute to Woodard. Retro tavern showcases auto-racing decor, a pool table and signs advertising Old Style and Rheingold beer. Managed by Sahm Hospitality Group.
- M Julieta Taco Shop/opening in July Founded by Milktooth chefs Esteban Rosas and Gabriel Sanudo. Shares its name with Sanudo's grandmother. Seats 16. A service window connects to Turner's Bar.

Event venue can accommodate 425 guests. Second location; first opened in Mass Ave in 2018.

O Cafe Patachou/opening in July
Flagship concept of Martha Hoover's
Won't Stop Hospitality Inc. One of
three Cafe Patachou spots opening
this year, adding to the five currently
operating in central Indiana.
